

**East Sac County Community School District
Food Service Program
September 11, 2020 - December 31, 2020 (end date is tentative)**

East Sac County Schools will transition to participating in the USDA Summer Food Service Program beginning September 11, 2020 through December 31, 2020 or earlier if the funds are exhausted. The program is closed which means it's only available to students enrolled at East Sac County CSD.

What does that mean for East Sac County students?

East Sac County students have the opportunity to have **one free breakfast** and **one free lunch** each day school is scheduled.

What does that mean for East Sac County students who chose online learning or are under quarantine?

East Sac County students under these options have the opportunity to have **one free breakfast** and **one free lunch** each day school is scheduled.

If you are a student that chose online learning or are under quarantine and wish to have breakfast or lunch, please call the building you want to pick up your student(s) meals at before 3:00 pm the day before you request your meals in order to have it ready for you to pick-up. The pick-up location will be the front entrance of the building you called and will be available at 11:00 AM, and you will receive 1 lunch and 1 breakfast per student. Are there any costs students will be required to pay?

The following purchases by students will still have a fee: "seconds" if allowable and available, ala carte items, extra milk, and juice as long as you have money in your student's meal account, no negative balance accounts will be allowed seconds, ala carte items, extra milk or juice. Adults' meals are still chargeable.
